Minutes:

1. Dr Hegde welcomed project collaborators and briefed about group wise meetings being conducted which will help in facilitation in coordination as well as better time management. Accordingly, separate meetings of veterinary, medical and NER-TAD Groups are being organized. Following are the topics of discussion from the veterinary group:
2. **Manpower Recruitment:** It was noted that all centres have recruited approved manpower except IVRI, Izatnagar. Therefore, IVRI centre was asked to speed up manpower recruitment.



3. **Equipment Procurement:** Most institutions have initiated the purchase process of non-recurring items. All collaborators were requested to procure approved equipment as quickly as possible.
4. **Diagnostics:** Dr Hegde intimated that efforts are being made to contact industries/suppliers for the availability of desired number of diagnostic kits required for the project based on the needs of various centres. Efforts are being made to negotiate prices of identified diagnostic kits and their smooth supply directly to centres so that payment can be made by respective centres only.
5. **Sample Collection:** Dr Suresh has already provided a table indicating the minimum number of samples to be collected from the number of villages in each state for identified diseases. It was decided that a minimum ten samples may be collected for each disease wherever no/ zero number is indicated in the table provided. Dr Suresh agreed to provide a detailed sample collection plan for each district shortly along with the number of villages for each state.
6. A discussion on a uniform questionnaire for identifying risk factors took place and Dr Suresh was requested to finalize the same.
7. For food borne diseases, Dr Barbudhe agreed to provide SoPs for collection of samples by 25th February 2022.
8. The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to all.
