

Minutes of 22nd meeting of the One Health Consortium
Venue: Virtual Mode, Groupwise meeting
Date and time: 3rd March 2022, 2.00pm-5.00 pm

Dr Subeer and Dr Hegde welcomed collaborators of different groups and a brief summary of points discussed in the meeting are as follows:

1. Dibrugarh, Nazareth Hospital and Gorakhpur Group:

- a. Memorandum of Agreement (MoA): Institutions were requested to submit MoA in Rs 100/ non- judicial stamp paper, as per DBT format, to NIAB at the earliest.
- b. SoPs: It was noted that SoPs for CCHF and Nipah has not been finalized. Based on discussion, the group requested experts to provide SoPs as follows:
 - i. AIIMS, Jodhpur for CCHF and
 - ii. Dr Barman for Nipah.

Dr Vikram Saini and Dr Kamran Zaman were requested to coordinate this activity.

- c. Disease data: As discussed earlier, statistics of identified human diseases for the last three years will help in finalizing number of samples to be collected. Dr Siraj Khan to provide statement of request to Dr Majumdar, who will follow up with Dr Saini to approach IDSP for the same.
- d. It was decided that medical institutions involved in the consortium will test minimum samples of all identified human diseases as per sample plan, which is yet to be finalized.
- e. Dr Siraj Khan and Dr Kamran were requested to finalize questionnaire.
- f. Actions on the minutes of meeting held on 21st Feb. 2022 has to be taken up.

2. AAU and centres of NE Region: AAU, Guwahati made a detailed presentation of sampling in states and also intimated about collection of samples.

- a. Memorandum of Agreement (MoA): Institutions ~~were~~^{are} requested to submit MoA in Rs 100/ non- judicial stamp paper, as per DBT format, to NIAB at the earliest.
- b. Sampling Plan and Size: Sampling size has already been finalized and a detailed district wise sampling plan to be provided to all collaborators at the earliest.





- c. Procurement of Diagnostic kits: This is being coordinated by Dr Nambi, TANUVAS and Dr Girish, NIAB and expected to be finalized soon which will help in procurement of diagnostics.
 - d. Group is also organizing a separate meeting on 11th March 22 in which sampling plan, sample collection, processing, information of data for future use, storage, coding of samples etc. will be discussed.
3. **TANUVAS and TNMGRMU:** Dr Nambi made a brief presentation and reported that sample collection has been started as per plan.
- a. Memorandum of Agreement (MoA): TANUVAS has to submit MoA in Rs 100/ non- judicial stamp paper, as per DBT format, to NIAB at the earliest.
 - b. Dr Nambi agreed to prepare a comparative table of costing of identified diagnostic kits of various diseases.
 - c. Brucellosis to be checked in contacts where animals are found to be positive.
