Venue: Virtual Mode


Topic: Interactive meet with NIVEDI, MAFSU

Date and time: 4th May 2022, 2.00pm onwards

Dr Rawat welcomed Prof. Kurkure, MAFSU and Dr K.P.Suresh, NIVEDI and other coinvestigators of respective institutes. He briefed about purpose of short interactive meetings. This was followed by discussion.

A brief of discussions on various issues is as follows:

MoA	Submitted	NIVEDI has submitted MoA directly to DBT earlier. Now a new MoA has been submitted to NIAB recently.
Progress Report	Submitted to NIAB	Submitted to NIAB
Sample collection	Samples from buffaloes, cattle, goats and sheep have been collected from district Bhandara(388) and Pune (96). Sampling from other districts/ states will be taken as per sampling plan. Centre was asked to speed up sample collection as per sampling plan and even more number of samples can be collected. It was suggested that this booklet can be annexed with the progress report as lot of efforts have been made towards this.
Manpower hiring	Manpower is in place as per approval.	Manpower recruited has resigned recently and process of fresh recruitment is underway.
Status of Equipment	Computer and few other approved miscellaneous equipment have been procured. Order has been placed for others.	Some of approved equipment have been procured and order has been placed for rest of approved equipment.
Procurement of Consumables/ diagnostic kits	Few of diagnostic kits of targeted diseases have been procured and order has been placed for others.	No diagnostic kits have to be procured
