

Minutes of 41st meeting of the One Health Consortium

Venue: Virtual Mode


Topic: Veterinary group - Issues related to kits, suppliers/vendors

Date and time: 6th July 2022, 5.00-6.00pm onwards

Attendees: All the veterinary investigators

Minutes:

1. Issues relating to availability of the kits as well as suppliers/vendors were discussed.
2. Prevalence for CCHF was discussed and it was noted that samples from 1930 cattle and 1765 goats have been projected to be tested. It was decided to order 50 kits each for cattle and goats. However, GADVASU investigators expressed concern that the kit needed to be stored at their site and that it funds would not be sufficient to carry out the testing as planned.
3. The test/kit for Q fever was quoted to have not been available with the earlier identified vendor, so it was decided to change the supplier.
4. For cryptosporidiosis, it was stated that the original manufacturer was no longer producing the kit; hence, it was decided to change the manufacturer. Peptide ELISA was decided to be validated during the project.
5. For ASF, since the disease is acute or peracute, it was decided to do PCR, but also continue serology whenever possible.
